Learn About How OA Functions

I am grateful that I had the opportunity to represent the DC-Metro Intergroup at the World Service Business Conference this year.

I found that attending WSBC virtually to be both exhausting and exhilarating, as the conference took place over multiple days in a row, four hours each day. However, I also found it extraordinary that as a fellowship we make decisions with each of us being exactly equal to every other person in the room, no matter what their role or position in the organization.

During the conference, we went over countless amendments to OA's bylaws and policies. I'd like to highlight two important policies that were revised at the recent World Service Business Conference.

<u>Policy on Abstinence and Recovery</u>. This policy was amended to revert back to the 2018 policy and to revise the recovery statement.

<u>Unity with Diversity Policy</u>. This policy was revised with grammar corrections and changes in wording to more correctly reflect how it applies to the Fellowship.

As I mentioned, there were many motions for discussion on the agenda. Because of the virtual nature of the conference, it was challenging for all delegates to follow all the discussions, especially those for whom English is not their first or primary language. There were several requests during the conference for speakers to slow down, though as a group of mostly North American-centric volunteers, everyone usually defaulted to the rapid speed and cadence of American English.

However, I am happy to report that there was a positive outcome as a result of this challenge: we are now going to have simultaneous translations at all future conferences. A committee will be working on this so that it is in action for the 2022 business conference, which is scheduled to be in-person.
